ABORIGINAL CLOTHING WINE BAG
The traditional clothing wine bag collections are beautifully hand-made, and they each represent a different aboriginal group.



SYMBOL ADULTHOOD NOTEBOOK AND PURSE
YuliTaki, a Taroko group designer, used her group's iconic totem which represents adulthood, to create the first high quality aboriginal premium brand in Taiwan.

DUMPLING TABLEWARE
Designed by Taiwanese local brand "Haka-Blue", this tableware is a condiment set. The designers are passionate about promoting simple elegance and vivid creativity.



MARRIAGE MUG
The handle of the mug is designed to bless a couple's marriage, so, when you put two handles together, they form the words "double happiness" (雙喜).

These seven masterpieces are created by Taiwan's bamboo sculptural artist Yeh Ji Shang. The artworks follow the natural outline shape of bamboo creating singing faces.

BUTTERFLY-3D PAPER ART
Papilio taiwanus is an iconic butterfly in Taiwan, the artwork requires one single sheet of paper it was created by Taiwan's famous 3D paper artist Hung Hsin-Fu.



PEACE DOVES
The turquoise coloured doves represent peace and harmony. The artist skillfully crafted the dove's back into the shape of Taiwan.
