



Kickoff of Asian Heritage Month and explorASIAN Festival 2022 with an in person Opening Ceremony, April 30

Vancouver, BC - March 28th, 2022 - To mark the beginning of Asian Heritage Month and explorASIAN Festival 2022, the Vancouver Asian Heritage Month Society (VAHMS) will hold an in person Opening Ceremony on April 30th, 2022 from 10:00am-12:00pm. The two-hour ceremony will feature a reception, live speeches by esteemed guests, an exhibition of art from VAHMS' Interconnected Artist Spotlight Series, and live performances to celebrate Asian Heritage Month and explorASIAN Festival 2022.

The ceremonies will include five performances by influential artists. Luke Kawabata, a Nikkei-Canadian baritone who is a current member of the Yulanda M Faris Young Artists' Program with Vancouver Opera, will sing O'Canada to kickoff the Opening. The proceeding performances will feature Eileen Kage and Noriko Kobayashi, two taiko veterans who will perform the explorASIAN Theme Song; Robyn Jacob and George Rahi, interdisciplinary artists and performers of Gamelan Tekanan Suara, a style of gamelan music played in Bali, Indonesia; Kasandra "La China" Flamenco, one of Canada's leading flamenco artists well-known for her unrelenting drive to push the artistic envelope; and, thanks to the generous sponsorship of the U.S. Consulate General Vancouver, ARKAI, an Asian American duo who won the 2021 Astral Artists National Auditions and continuously use their music to challenge preconceptions, bridge social and cultural divides, and cultivate peace-building.

As well, the following iconic Vancouver attractions will be illuminated in red to celebrate Asian Heritage Month:

- · May 3rd: Canada Place
