PROFILE

The Vancouver Asian Heritage Month Society (VAHMS) is a community-focused non-profit organization that was formed in 1996 as a response to the limited opportunities available to Asian Canadians artists in the mainstream arts and culture community.

We believe deeply in the importance of stories, the transformative power of art and the ability of both to foster positive change and social cohesion. Our signature project is **explorASIAN Festival**, Vancouver's oldest and longest-running Asian Heritage Month celebration. The festival showcases the multitude of talent and aspirations of the greater Pan-Asian community, and their contributions to Canadian communities.





FOUNDER

Jim Wong-Chu, Iconic Asian Canadian was a writer, photographer, historian, radio producer, community organizer and activist, editor, and literary and cultural engineer.

He was the founder of the Asian Canadian Writer's Workshop and Ricepaper magazine, and wrote the groundbreaking 1986 poetry book Chinatown Ghosts. Born in 1949 in Hong Kong, he was sent to live with his aunt and uncle in Canada as a "paper son". The term referred to the practice of children who immigrated to Canada by using real or falsified identification papers of relatives living in Canada. His story alone is a poignant example that narratives about identity can effect powerful change.

Jim Wong-Chu along with Mishtu Banerjee, Mo-Ling Chui, Grace Eiko Thomson and Winston Xin formed the Vancouver Asian Heritage Month Society, as an organization that endeavoured to explore the diversity of Asian Canadian life and culture and promote the discussion of relevant issues and concerns within and beyond the Asian Canadian communities.



MISSION & VALUES

VAHMS' mission is to foster, promote and celebrate the arts and cultural diversity that Asian Canadian communities bring to Canadian society.

We bring this mission to life by educating the wider community about the importance of Asian Canadian arts and culture in Canadian society; creating opportunities for Asian Canadians to network, collaborate and expand in public arts and cultural spaces; facilitating and promoting explorASIAN, a Metro-Vancouver festival showcasing pan-Asian Canadian arts and culture during Asian Heritage Month in May; and, providing a safe platform to address critical issues facing Asian Canadians and discuss solutions to foster inclusion and diversity in Canadian society.

OUR VALUES, WHICH ARE THE PRINCIPLES AND FOUNDATIONS UPON WHICH WE OPERATE, ARE:

- * Equitable collaboration
- * Diversity of ideas
- * Inclusive and accessible spaces
- * Kindness and openness

We also acknowledge that the recognition and appreciation of Indigenous Peoples by Asian Canadian communities is not as widespread as it should be. Indigenous Peoples have given much wisdom and strength to Asian Canadian communities now and in the past. We are working to increase awareness on this lost history by engaging more with Indigenous Peoples and educating ourselves. Although it is just the beginning for VAHMS, we hope to expand our programming to include the culture and arts space shared between Asian Canadian communities and Indigenous Communities.

EVENTS

EXPLORASIAN OPENING CEREMONY - APRIL/MAY; ANNUALLY

The official ceremony to kick off the Society's signature event, explorASIAN Festival, during Asian Heritage Month in May. The festival is the premier platform for Metro Vancouver's pan-Asian Canadian artists and communities to connect and promote their art and culture. The Opening Ceremony Includes a reception, remarks by esteemed guests, an exhibition of art from VAHMS' Interconnected Artist Spotlight Series, and live performances.

VAHMS also works together with local and national partners to create its own signature events for the festival, including but not limited to exhibitions, events on Asian Canadian art appreciation and discussion, events highlighting Asian Canadian experiences, networking events, and a Community Awards Ceremony.

NATIONAL CANADIAN FILM DAY - ANNUALLY

In collaboration with Reel Canada, a screening of an Independent Canadian Film produced by an Asian Canadian filmmaker

ON THE MOVE: NATIONAL SHOWCASE - ANNUALLY

In collaboration with Festival Acces Asie (Montreal), Asian Heritage Society of Manitoba, and VAHMS, this showcase presents Asian Canadian artists, followed by a discussion period with the artists.

VAHMS COMMUNITY AWARDS CELEBRATION - ANNUALLY

Wrap-up gala to celebrate and recognize the explorASIAN Festival contributors who continue to uphold our mission of appreciating Pan-Asian Canadian arts and culture
